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The Sunrise Virtual School student wakes up to an easy morning since school comes to them as opposed to going to school, convenience redefined!



Classes **start** at **8:30 a.m.** up to **1 O'clock** for the reception level and **8:30 - 3:10** for years 1 - 3 with breaks in between.

Year 4 to year 11 start their classes with an assembly or The **D.E.A.R (Drop Everything And Read)** programme at **7:30 a.m.** and end their day at **3:30 p.m.** They have two major breaks one between **11 a.m to 11:45 a.m.** and the other between **1 to 2 O'clock.**

They all engage in different activities throughout the day both academic and social specifically designed for their levels.

Learning is made easy since they can join classes through their dashboards and access anything they require for a class through an easy process that does not require extra help from parents. The sessions are live and interactive, learner-led but teacher-guided.

They are also able to receive tests, homework, notes and even reports regularly while being able to access their teachers even after school through the dashboard.

Our day ends with a hang-out where we gather as a class and just 'chill' on Fridays but on other days classes end and boom! We are in recess!
